

Linslade Winter Walk and Pub Tour

Sunday 8th January 2012

For those going by bus from Luton/Dunstable the Arriva #70 leaves Luton Silver Street at 10.40 and Dunstable High Street North Bus Stop L at 11.14 arriving in Leighton Buzzard High Street at 11.39.

All walkers should assemble outside the Golden Bell at 11.45 (*it opens at 11.00 for those who fancy a coffee or something stronger to keep out the winter chill.*)

We'll leave the Golden Bell at 11.50 and walk the short distance to the river (not canal). We'll follow the river for a mile to Plantation Road which we'll walk along for about 300 yards before turning off and heading cross-country for a further mile towards Old Linslade where we'll join the Grand Union Canal. A further half mile walk along the canal towpath will take us to the Globe.

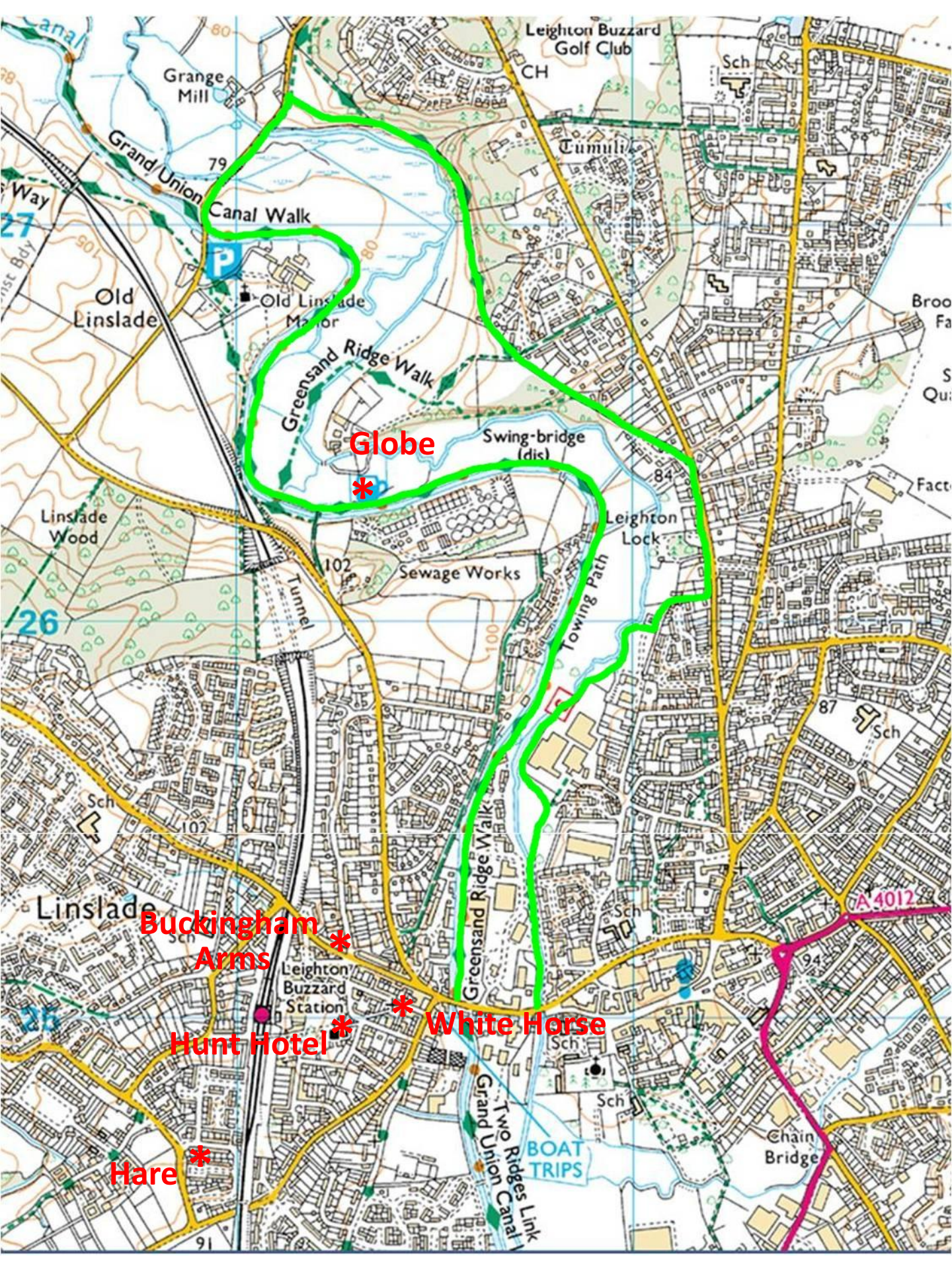
We should arrive at the Globe around 13.00 for a beer (or beers), lunch (if needed) and possibly a warm-up/defrost/drying out by the fire.

At 14.15 approx. we'll leave the Globe and continue down the canal for a mile towards Linslade. and then a further half mile to the Hare arriving at around 15.00.

Time and inclination permitting there may be visits to the Buckingham Arms, Hunt Hotel and finally the White Horse.

Buses leave the railway station at 17.47 and 19.45 for the return journey to Dunstable and Luton.
